## Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Talofa lava. We do hope all our families are safe and looking after their health.

Government (MESC) have stated that Primary Schools will be allowed to reopen **on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May.** Initially, we would like all classes, from Year 1 to Year 8 to come in on that day, to see what our numbers are, so that we can work out a timetable for classes to come to school. We will then inform parents of days for classes.

The school calendar is being altered to cater for the recent lockdown of 8 weeks. Each term will be 9 weeks long with a one week break for holidays to ensure children get maximum tutorial time.

In order for children to resume classes from the 30th May, they need to have:

- Paid Term 1 fees in full.
- Paid Term 2 Fees in full. For parents who have paid for the weekly packages for the 1, 2, 3, 4 and/or five weeks, this amount will be deducted from \$700 for Term 2 Fees. You are asked to please pay the difference before or on 30<sup>th</sup> May.

In order for students to begin class, they must

- wear a mask.
- produce their vaccination certificate to verify that they have had their Pfizer 2 injections.
- bring their own drink bottle.

There will be no 'Teacher Only Days' on Mondays, at the beginning of each term.
